

RESOLUTION ON ELIGIBILITY TO USE THE STUDENT GRIEVANCE POLICY  
(#01-94/95-SA)

- WHEREAS, An approved Humboldt State University Student Grievance Policy is currently in place at Humboldt State University; and
- WHEREAS, There has been some confusion as to the definition of a student who can use the student grievance policy; and
- WHEREAS, An ad hoc committee exists which is carefully reviewing the structure, purpose and function of the Student Grievance Committee; and
- WHEREAS, This same committee is critically considering the student grievance policy and procedures for revision which will then come before all appropriate student, faculty and administrative bodies for input and consultation; therefore, be it
- RESOLVED: That the Academic Senate of Humboldt State University support during the 1994-95 academic year, the interim policy for eligibility to use the student grievance procedure, printed below, for defining a student while the current policy is undergoing review; and be it further
- RESOLVED: That the Academic Senate of Humboldt State University recommend that "eligibility" be addressed with all other issues during the process of review of the student grievance policy and procedure.

Eligibility to use the Student Grievance Procedure

Any student or student at the time that the alleged event occurred may use the Student Grievance Procedure. For the purpose of this procedure, a student is defined as any person taking courses at Humboldt State University, either full-time or part-time, including summer session and Extended Education. The grievant must initiate Step 2 of the existing procedure (transmittal of written statement of grievance to the department chair or supervisor of the person whose action is alleged to have injured unjustly the student) prior to the last day of classes of the first semester following the semester in which the alleged incident was discovered.
