

RESOLUTION ON THE DUTIES FOR THE FACULTY DEVELOPMENT COMMITTEE  
(#04-94/95-EP)

- WHEREAS, Faculty development takes place at a number of levels in the university; and
- WHEREAS, Faculty development efforts at the different levels of the university could benefit from the advice of the Faculty Development Committee; and
- WHEREAS, The charge of the Faculty Development Committee specifies advising only the Faculty Development Coordinator; and
- WHEREAS, It is important not to replace the Faculty Development Coordinator with the Faculty Development Committee in the role of coordinating faculty development; therefore, be it
- RESOLVED: That the Academic Senate of Humboldt State University recommends that the second sentence under Duties of the Faculty Development Committee, as stated in Section 836 of the Faculty Handbook and printed below, be changed to read, "Advises and assists the Coordinator or others in matters of faculty development." And be it further
- RESOLVED: That the Academic Senate of Humboldt State University recommends that the position of Faculty Development Coordinator be filled so that the Faculty Development Committee not be perceived as replacing the Faculty Development Coordinator in the role of coordinating faculty development.

**FACULTY DEVELOPMENT COMMITTEE**

- Duties:** Recommends the Faculty Development Coordinator who is then appointed by the Academic Vice President. Advises and assists the Coordinator in matters of faculty development.
- Chair:** Elected from membership
- Type:** Ad Hoc Committee of the Academic Senate
- Meetings:** As needed
- Membership:** Appointed by the Senate Appointments Committee. Two to three members who serve for one-year terms which may be extended.
