

Resolution on Remediation
(#05-96/97-EP)

WHEREAS, Basic skills in English and Mathematics are crucial to academic success at HSU; and

WHEREAS, Many HSU students are admitted to the University with deficiencies in these two areas as measured by scores on the English Placement Test and the Entry Level Mathematics exam; and

WHEREAS, A significant number of junior and senior level students have yet to complete their required remediation in English and Mathematics; and

WHEREAS, Current HSU policy requires juniors or seniors transferring to the University to have completed any required remediation; therefore, be it

RESOLVED: That the Academic Senate of Humboldt State University recommends that effective Fall 1998, any student who attains junior standing and has not completed all required remediation may enroll only in remedial classes until all remedial requirements have been met; and be it further

RESOLVED: That the Academic Senate of Humboldt State University recommends that effective Fall 1997, when a student attains sophomore standing without completing all required remediation, Admissions and Records shall notify the student and his or her advisor of the non-completion of the required remediation and the consequences of failure to complete the required remediation prior to attaining junior standing.
