

**RESOLUTION ON ESTABLISHING PARAMETERS FOR COMPLETION  
OF THE BASIC SUBJECTS AND QUANTITATIVE REASONING  
AREAS OF GENERAL EDUCATION  
(#06-02/03-EP)**

- WHEREAS: The Basic Subjects General Education courses (oral communication, English and critical thinking) and the General Education quantitative reasoning requirement serve as the foundation upon which other aspects of university education are built; and
- WHEREAS: It is important that these courses be completed early in the students' academic careers; and
- WHEREAS: There is evidence that the completion of these courses by students often occurs late in their university experience; and
- WHEREAS: Transfer students from the California Community Colleges (CCC) are required to complete the Basic Subjects General Education courses and the General Education quantitative reasoning requirement prior to acceptance in the California State University system, while transfer students from outside the CCC may not have completed their coursework in these areas; therefore, be it
- RESOLVED: That the Academic Senate of Humboldt State University recommend that all Basic Subjects General Education courses and the General Education quantitative reasoning requirement be completed by students admitted to Humboldt State University as freshmen prior to those students completing 60 semester units of study; and be it further
- RESOLVED: That the Academic Senate of Humboldt State University recommend that transfer students who have not completed the Basic Subjects General Education courses and the General Education quantitative reasoning requirement be given provisional admission with two terms to complete said requirements; and be it further
- RESOLVED: That the Academic Senate of Humboldt State University recommend that students who do not complete the Basic Subjects General Education courses and the General Education quantitative reasoning requirement within the described parameters be disqualified; and be it further
- RESOLVED: That the Academic Senate of Humboldt State University recommend that the policy specified in this resolution relative to completion of the Basic Subjects General Education courses and the General Education quantitative reasoning requirement become effective in the 2004-2005 academic year.
