RESOLUTION ON TEACH CSU (#08-01/02-JT)

WHEREAS, The Humboldt Chapter of the California Faculty Association is sponsoring a Teach CSU project on October 17 to explore how faculty working conditions affect learning; and

WHEREAS, A variety of projects will be addressed during this event, including:

- 1. The importance of student faculty ratios
