WHEREAS, It was the intention of the initial faculty committee that defined Adjunct Professor status to allow Adjunct Professors to become Emeritus faculty (see reverse); therefore, be it

RESOLVED: That the Academic Senate of Humboldt State University recommend that upon the advice of an Adjunct Professor's department and college, that he or she be designated Adjunct Professor Emeritus with the rights and privileges of emeritus faculty upon his or her retirement; and be it further

RESOLVED: That the Academic Senate of Humboldt State University recommend that the faculty constitution be amended to recognize the position, Adjunct Professor Emeritus.

I wish to recommend that the Faculty Senate establish Adjunct

on them all the privileges of Emeritus Faculty, as defined in the Faculty
Handbook.


Frankly I am surprised that this action is deemed necessary. Having
been a member of the original faculty committee which voluntarily met
one summer and developed the HSU Faculty Constitution, and then having
endured through the hearings until the Constitution was adopted, I had
assumed that Adjunct Professors who met the criteria for Emeritus status
as stated in the Faculty Handbook were *pro forma* Emeritus. I had had the
distinction of writing the original definition of Adjunct Professors for the
original committee, and the intent was always to include Adjunct
Professors in faculty privileges. They simply constituted another
category of Professors. I also collaborated with Milton Dobkin in the
definition of what constituted Emeritus Status at HSU for the Faculty
Handbook, and which was subsequently adopted for the Handbook.

The intent has been plain from the beginning. ...Adjunct Professors
are Professors; they simply have an adjective modification of their title.
I hope the HSU Senate acts affirmatively and quickly in conferring Adjunct
Professors who meet the definition of Emeritus as stated in the Faculty
Handbook, the status of Emeritus at Humboldt State University, with all of
the privileges conferred by the status as defined by the Faculty Handbook.

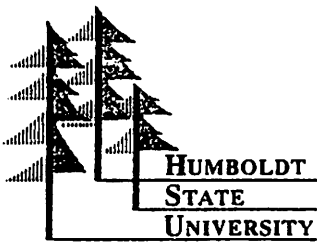
