

RESOLUTION ON AWARDING HONORS ON A GPA BASIS

(#09-92/93-EP)

- WHEREAS, Awarding honors on a percentage basis by college does not allow students to know whether they will graduate with honors until long after graduation; and
- WHEREAS, Awarding honors on a University-wide GPA basis would allow students to know in a timely fashion if they qualify for honors; therefore, be it
- RESOLVED: That the Academic Senate of Humboldt State University recommends that honors be based upon the following GPA's: (Summa Cum Laude: 3.85-4.00, Magna Cum Laude: 3.70-3.84, and Cum Laude: 3.50-3.69); and be it further
- RESOLVED: That the Academic Senate of Humboldt State University recommends that the current 30-unit requirement of letter grades at HSU for honors qualification continue; and be it further
- RESOLVED: That the Academic Senate of Humboldt State University recommends that the GPA basis be checked periodically by Admissions, Records and School Relations so that the number of students graduating with honors stays between ten and fifteen percent.
