RESOLUTION ON CURRICULAR OVERSIGHT OF THE INSTITUTIONS REQUIREMENT  
(#09-95/96-EP)

- WHEREAS, The University Curriculum Committee is responsible for the oversight and coordination of university-wide requirements; and
- WHEREAS, Title 5, Article 5, mandates that CSU graduates complete a course of study in United States History, Constitution and American Ideals (i.e., Institutions Requirement); and
- WHEREAS, The University Curriculum Committee generally is responsible for courses and requirements which cross college boundaries; and
- WHEREAS, Three departments (History, Political Science, and Business & Economics) from two separate colleges teach in the institutions area; therefore, be it
- RESOLVED: That the Academic Senate of Humboldt State University recommends to the Vice President for Academic Affairs and to the President that the University Curriculum Committee be responsible for the curricular oversight of the Institutions Requirement after consultation with the appropriate departments and colleges.
