

RESOLUTION ON THE STRUCTURE OF THE  
UNIVERSITY CURRICULUM COMMITTEE  
(#10-96/97-EP)

WHEREAS, The number of colleges has been reduced to three and, therefore, the membership on the University Curriculum Committee (UCC) would be reduced by two faculty members; and

WHEREAS, The new university structure has two large colleges and one college moderate in size; and

WHEREAS, It is important to maintain the different perspectives of the colleges; and

WHEREAS, Students should have an opportunity to make significant input into the curriculum; therefore, be it

RESOLVED: That the Academic Senate of Humboldt State University recommend that the faculty approve the following changes to the Faculty Handbook during the Spring of 1997:

1. Faculty membership will include three members each from the College of Arts, Humanities and Social Sciences and the College of Natural Resources and Sciences and two members from the College of Professional Studies. Each college will nominate members from its college (at least two for each vacancy) who will then be elected by the University at large. College members will serve three-year overlapping terms.
2. Student membership will be four students, with at least one student selected from each college, appointed by the President of the Associated Students with the consent of the Student Legislative Council, to serve one-year terms; and be it further

RESOLVED: That the Academic Senate of Humboldt State University recommend that if the above changes are approved by a vote of the faculty, then elections be held in the Spring of 1997 reflecting those changes; and be it further

RESOLVED: That the Academic Senate of Humboldt State University recommend that the above changes, if approved, be implemented in the Fall of 1997.
