

**RESOLUTION REGARDING CR/NC GRADING FOR GRADUATE STUDENTS
TAKING UNDERGRADUATE COURSES
(#12-00/01-SA)**

WHEREAS, Current HSU policy places unclassified graduate students, second bachelor's degree students, teaching credential students, Over-60 Program students, and classified master's degree students in the same category; and

WHEREAS, Most of those categories are students not seeking a master's degree; and

WHEREAS, The current CR/NC policy applies a higher standard for all graduate students taking undergraduate courses, not just those seeking a master's degree; and

WHEREAS, Those non-master's students should not be subjected to the higher CR/NC standard; therefore, be it

RESOLVED: That the Academic Senate of Humboldt State University recommend a change in the CR/NC policy for undergraduate courses so that only classified master's degree students be subjected to the higher CR/NC standard that A through B- are the only grades to receive credit; and be it further

RESOLVED: That the Academic Senate of Humboldt State University recommend that all other students currently considered to be graduate; namely, unclassified graduate students, second bachelor's degree students, teaching credential students, and Over-60 Program students, when taking undergraduate courses for CR/NC, be subjected to the undergraduate standard that A through C- are the only grades to receive credit.
