Resolution on Periodic Evaluations of Temporary Faculty with Three-Year Appointments

#13-07/08-FA - April 29, 2008

RESOLVED: That the Academic Senate of Humboldt State University recommends to the President that temporary faculty members with three-year appointments be evaluated annually.

RATIONALE: Article 15.26 in the new Collective Bargaining Agreement, states:

Temporary faculty unit employees holding three (3) year appointments pursuant to Article 12 shall be evaluated at least once during the term of their appointment and may be evaluated more frequently upon the request of either the employee or the President.

HSU temporary employees have in the past been evaluated annually. These evaluations have been seen as a professional development tool in addition to the necessary evaluation of the faculty member's performance. Annual evaluations provide a check in the event that a faculty member's performance becomes less than satisfactory, permitting time for feedback prior to a new 3-year appointment.
