

**RESOLUTION ON ATHLETIC GRANTS  
(#18-97/98-SA)**

**WHEREAS,** The General Faculty of Humboldt State University has voted to endorse the principle of provision of athletic grants, and

**WHEREAS,** It is a concern of the faculty that the provision of such grants be in keeping with the overall mission of the University and function to create further access for a diversity of students, and

**WHEREAS,** It is in the interest of the Humboldt State community that the tradition of close relationships between the athletics programs and the academic programs of the University be continued, be it therefore

**RESOLVED:** That the Academic Senate of Humboldt State University recommend that the provision of athletic grants include the provision of both merit based and need based grants, and be it further

**RESOLVED:** That the Academic Senate of Humboldt State University recommend that the fund raising in support of such grants be designed to attract new dollars to the Humboldt State campus such that funds currently available to programs are not reduced, and be it further

**RESOLVED:** That the Academic Senate of Humboldt State University recommend the establishment of an Athletic Grants and Aid Compliance Committee whose charge shall be to develop policies for the implementation and continued oversight of the athletic grants program and to identify and develop such procedures or institutional structures as may be necessary to the successful operation of such a program, and be it further

**RESOLVED:** That the Academic Senate of Humboldt State University recommend that the initial membership of the Athletic Grants and Aid Compliance Committee will include two faculty - the Chairperson of the Student Affairs Committee of the Senate or his or her designee and a faculty representative appointed by the Senate Appointments Committee; two students - an Associated Students representative and a student athlete representative; representatives of the offices of Financial Aid, Admission & Records, and Student Affairs; two coaches, and the Athletic Director, and that the initial meeting of the committee be convened by the Athletic Director.
