Resolution on Classroom Disruptive Student Behavior Policy

RESOLVED: That the University Senate of Humboldt State University recommends to the Provost that the attached revisions to the Classroom Disruptive Student Behavior Policy be adopted.

RATIONALE: The Office of Student Rights and Responsibilities proposed changes and updates to provide clear guidelines and procedures for students and faculty across the university. In the process of making the requested changes it was determine that there was no formal university policy in regard to disruptive student behavior in the classroom. Incidents of disruptive behavior have addressed in accordance with executive orders and university practices. This policy will establish a formal process for the university. In accordance with the Policy on Policies the procedures have been separated out into a separate document that will be updated by the Office of Student rights and Responsibilities in consultation with the Academic Policies Committee.
