

RESOLUTION ON GENERAL FACULTY ELECTION RESULTS POLICY
(#21-97/98-EX)

WHEREAS, There is no official policy that prescribes the reporting of general faculty election results; therefore be it

RESOLVED: That the Academic Senate of Humboldt State University recommend that the following General Faculty Election Results Policy be implemented:

General Faculty Election Results Policy

1. The conduct of general faculty elections falls within the province of the general faculty president; therefore, all queries regarding general faculty election results are to be directed to the general faculty president.
2. The general faculty president will announce general faculty election results according to the following guidelines:

The general faculty president will announce the names of faculty members who have been elected to office by their colleagues. The candidates will be notified of the election results prior to the public announcement. Only faculty members running for a specific elected office can request and receive their individual vote count associated with an elected office vote.

The general faculty president will announce the results of referenda, including the vote count and percentages of the referenda.

3. The General Faculty Election Results Policy is effective Spring Semester 1998.
