- WHEREAS, On January 21, 2002, the Academic Senate Chair appointed an ad hoc committee to examine and revise the *Constitution of the General Faculty of HSU* (Appendix E, Faculty Handbook) and the *Bylaws and Rules of Procedure of the Academic Senate of Humboldt State University* (Appendix F, Faculty Handbook), and
- WHEREAS, The ad hoc committee, during its review over the course of two years, discovered a need to clarify and update the Constitution and Bylaws to reflect modern practices, and remove redundancies across the two appendices, and
- WHEREAS, The Academic Senate has reviewed and approved the proposed revisions to Appendix F, the *Bylaws and Rules of Procedure of the Academic Senate of Humboldt State University*, and
- WHEREAS, Changes to Appendix E, the *Constitution of the General Faculty of HSU*, reflect no changes in policy, and correspond to changes in Appendix F; therefore be it
- RESOLVED: That the Academic Senate of Humboldt State University recommends the proposed revision of Appendix E, *Constitution of the General Faculty of HSU*, be forwarded to the General Faculty for a vote of acceptance or rejection at the General Faculty election on May 11-12, 2004.
