

Resolution on Reorganization of the Colleges (#24-90/91-EX)

WHEREAS, The President has requested that the Humboldt State University Academic Senate review a structural reorganization of the colleges as recommended in the Vice President of Academic Affairs' memo dated April 9, 1991; and

WHEREAS, The structural reorganization of the colleges at HSU recommended in the Vice President of Academic Affairs' memo dated April 9, 1991 is based on extensive consultation with the faculty and staff at HSU; and

WHEREAS, The structural reorganization of the colleges at HSU recommended in the Vice President of Academic Affairs' memo dated April 9, 1991 incorporates the guidelines outlined in HSU Academic Senate Resolution #17-90/91-EX passed on February 19, 1991; therefore, be it

RESOLVED: That the Academic Senate of Humboldt State University endorses the structural reorganization of the colleges recommended in the Vice President for Academic Affairs' memo dated April 9, 1991 (see attachment); and be it further

RESOLVED: That the Academic Senate of Humboldt State University recommends that the President implement the structural reorganization of the colleges recommended in the Vice President of Academic Affairs' memo dated April 9, 1991 as soon as is feasible and possible.
