RESOLUTION TO ENDORSE THE CREATION OF A SOLID WASTE MANAGEMENT TASK FORCE AT HUMBOLDT STATE UNIVERSITY (#24-91/92-SA)

- WHEREAS, The State of California is the largest solid waste producing state in the Union; and
- WHEREAS, The State of California has enacted legislation, AB 939, which mandates that all counties and cities adopt a Solid Waste Management Plan to reduce the volume of waste to the landfill by fifty percent by the beginning of the twenty-first century; and
- WHEREAS, The California Integrated Waste Management Board has recognized the need for all CSU campuses to have a Solid Waste Management Plan; and
- WHEREAS, There exist five separate agencies; Plant Operations, Lumberjack Enterprises, Arcata Garbage, Arcata Community Recycling Center and the Campus Recycling Program, each handling solid waste at Humboldt State University; and
- WHEREAS, There exists no Solid Waste Management Plan to guide these agencies in reducing waste at Humboldt State University; therefore be it
- RESOLVED: That the Academic Senate of Humboldt State University endorses the creation of a Solid Waste Management Task Force to study the need for a Solid Waste Management Plan at Humboldt State University.
