

RESOLUTION ON FACULTY WITHDRAWAL OF STUDENTS
(#24-92/93-EP)

- WHEREAS, The 1990-91 Humboldt State University catalog was changed to read that in the first two weeks of class "As a matter of University policy, the instructor in the class may not drop on a student's behalf"; and
- WHEREAS, The Academic Senate of Humboldt State University has been asked by a faculty member to look into the rationale for this change; and
- WHEREAS, With the limited amount of space in courses it would help both students and faculty if faculty had the option to drop students who do not comply with University policies governing the first week of class attendance; therefore, be it
- RESOLVED: That the Academic Senate of Humboldt State University recommends that effective Fall 1993 faculty be allowed to drop students prior to the third week of classes in accordance with University policies governing the first week of class attendance; and be it further
- RESOLVED: That the Academic Senate of Humboldt State University recommends that students be notified of the revised drop policy in a timely manner, and be it further
- RESOLVED: That the Academic Senate of Humboldt State University recommends that the catalog reflect that faculty have the option to drop students in accordance with University policies governing the first week of class attendance; and be it further
- RESOLVED: That the Academic Senate of Humboldt State University recommends that the catalog reflect that it is students' responsibility to contact instructors to verify enrollment status if they have missed class during the first week of instruction.
