Resolution to Vote on Faculty Handbook Change Specific to Term of Office (#28-91/92-EX)

- WHEREAS, Humboldt State University is a complex organization; and
- WHEREAS, Elected general faculty officers at Humboldt State University are elected each Spring for a one-year term; and
- WHEREAS, Some time is required to understand one's roles and responsibilities in each office of the general faculty at Humboldt State University; and
- WHEREAS, Becoming oriented to the myriad of new information received as the result of being a general faculty officer at Humboldt State University is necessary to best serve the faculty constituency; and
- WHEREAS, Elections for general faculty officers at Humboldt State University can be a time-consuming and cumbersome process; therefore, be it
- RESOLVED: That the Academic Senate of Humboldt State University recommends that the following suggested Faculty Handbook change be put to a vote of the general faculty of Humboldt State University:

CURRENT HANDBOOK: APPENDIX E "Constitution of the General Faculty of Humboldt State University" Article IV. Section 33 - Term of Office - The General Faculty president, secretary, and treasurer shall be elected by majority vote and shall hold office from the 1st of May following their election through the 30th of April of the following year.

SUGGESTED CHANGE: Article IV. Section 33 - Term of Office. The General Faculty president, secretary, and treasurer will each serve two-year terms. The terms of office will commence on the 1st of May following their election, and will end on the 30th of April, two years later; and be it further

RESOLVED: That the Academic Senate of Humboldt State University recommends that the change in term of office of general faculty officers at Humboldt State University from one to two years, if approved, commence with the Spring, 1993 General Faculty elections.
