

Resolution to Vote on Faculty Handbook Change Specific to
Assigned Time for University Faculty Personnel Committee
(UFPC) Members (#29-91/92-EX)

WHEREAS, Budget pressures at Humboldt State University have forced a careful review of appropriate use of faculty governance assigned time allocations; and

WHEREAS, The Executive Committee of the Academic Senate of Humboldt State University has been asked to recommend faculty governance use; and

WHEREAS, Faculty governance needs at Humboldt State University may change year to year requiring an increasing ability to be flexible; and

WHEREAS, The Faculty Handbook of Humboldt State University stipulates a firm commitment of University Faculty Personnel Committee (UFPC) release time "equivalent to one-half of a full teaching load" (Appendix J, Section VII, D, 2a); therefore, be it

RESOLVED: That the Academic Senate of Humboldt State University recommends that the General Faculty of Humboldt State University vote on the following proposed change in the Faculty Handbook:

CURRENT HANDBOOK: Appendix J, Section VII, D. University Faculty Personnel Committee, 2. Organization (a) The UFPC shall be composed of five members holding the rank of full professor or librarian. The term of office shall be two years, during which time each member shall receive assigned time equivalent to one-half of a full teaching load.

PROPOSED CHANGE: Appendix J, Section VII, D. University Faculty Personnel Committee, 2. Organization (a) The UFPC shall be composed of five members holding the rank of full professor or librarian. The term of office shall be two years. Faculty members serving on UFPC shall receive a minimum of .25 assigned time, with the chair receiving .50 assigned time. The amount of assigned time may be augmented through the faculty governance recommending process of the Executive Committee of the Academic Senate; and be it further

RESOLVED: That the Academic Senate of Humboldt State University recommends that if the vote changing the Humboldt State University Faculty Handbook to provide flexibility in UFPC assigned time is successful, that the above change begin in Fall, 1994 with Spring, 1993 elections.
