## Resolution on Discontinuance of Undergraduate Programs at Humboldt State University (#30-90/91-EX)

- WHEREAS, Humboldt State University is apparently facing an unprecedented budget crisis; and
- WHEREAS, The President of Humboldt State University has requested advice from the Academic Senate on recommendations from the Expanded ARAC Committee to discontinue the Home Economics, Industrial Technology, Range Management, and Speech & Hearing Sciences undergraduate programs at HSU; and
- WHEREAS, The Academic Senate of Humboldt State University has reviewed the recommendations from the Expanded ARAC Committee to discontinue the Home Economics, Industrial Technology, Range Management, and Speech & Hearing Sciences programs at Humboldt State University; and
- WHEREAS, The Academic Senate of Humboldt State University has received and reviewed oral and/or written comment from the faculty of the Home Economics, Industrial Technology, Range Management, and Speech & Hearing Sciences programs and from campus and community individuals and organizations interested in these programs; and
- WHEREAS, The Academic Senate at Humboldt State University believes that the value of the Industrial Technology, Range Management, and Speech & Hearing Programs to the diversity and quality of education at Humboldt State University and to the local community is great enough to warrant the absorption of the possible \$104,280 to \$561,587 savings in 1991/92 that could be realized by their discontinuance by cuts in other academic programs; therefore, be it
- RESOLVED: That the Academic Senate of Humboldt State University recommends that the President implement the recommendation of the Extended ARAC Committee to discontinue the Home Economics Program at Humboldt State University; and be it further
- RESOLVED: That the Academic Senate of Humboldt State University recommends that the President <u>not</u> implement the recommendation of the Extended ARAC Committee to discontinue the Industrial Technology Program at Humboldt State University; and be it further
- RESOLVED: That the Academic Senate of Humboldt State University recommends that the President <u>not</u> implement the recommendation of the Extended ARAC Committee to discontinue the Range Management Program at Humboldt State University and that the OAA subsidy to the Range Management Program be eliminated; and be it further
- RESOLVED: That the Academic Senate of Humboldt State University recommends that the President <u>not</u> implement the recommendation of the Extended ARAC Committee to discontinue the Speech & Hearing Sciences Program at Humboldt State University.
