STAFFING OF THE FORT ORD CAMPUS

- WHEREAS, Even though the State of California is in a budget crisis, the Trustees of the California State University are considering establishing a new campus at Fort Ord; and
- WHEREAS, The expense of staffing this campus will have a major impact on the budget of the CSU; and
- WHEREAS, The California State University is faced with the possibility of laying off well-qualified faculty on some of its campuses; and
- WHEREAS, It is desirable that the Fort Ord campus be staffed with individuals familiar with the needs of the State of California and its diverse student population; and
