

RESOLUTION TO RESTRUCTURE THE ADVISING PROCESS  
(#40-92/93-FLR)

- WHEREAS, The average graduation time of a CSU Student in 1989 was three years and now the average graduation time is 7.4 years; and
- WHEREAS, One of the purposes of the CSU is to provide full matriculation and in order to fulfill this goal of matriculation the University needs to facilitate an environment that will help students to graduate in the quickest time possible without impairing the quality of education; and
- WHEREAS, In order to create this environment the University needs to provide students with the opportunity to obtain free information regarding their status toward graduation. Thus, the full responsibility of a student's progress may be at his or her disposal; and
- WHEREAS, It is imperative that the University reform the advising system in order to enhance the quality of education at HSU; therefore, be it
- RESOLVED: That the Academic Senate of Humboldt State University recommends that at the time of initial contact with the faculty advisor of the declared major, that the advisor is provided with a current graduation degree check of the advisee; and be it further
- RESOLVED: That the Academic Senate of Humboldt State University recommend that the major degree contract be expanded to include lower and upper division general education requirements so that the student will know exactly where he or she stands in order to complete the University requirements for graduation; and be it further
- RESOLVED: That the Academic Senate of Humboldt State University recommends that two semesters previous to a student's intended graduation date, a second graduation check be provided at no additional cost to the student.
