

RESOLUTION ON PROXIES FOR THE ACADEMIC SENATE  
(#09-91/92-FA)

- WHEREAS, There has arisen uncertainty concerning the use of proxies in the Academic Senate of Humboldt State University; and
- WHEREAS, Custom has called for the principle of one vote per person in the Academic Senate of Humboldt State University; and
- WHEREAS, The Parliamentary Authority (Sturgis Standard Code of Parliamentary Procedure, Second Edition) concerning proxies does permit one person to cast more than one vote when given the appropriate proxy; therefore, be it
- RESOLVED: That the Academic Senate of Humboldt State University wishes to affirm the Parliamentary Authority (Sturgis Standard Code of Parliamentary Procedure, Second Edition) regarding appropriate proxy; and be it further
- RESOLVED: That the Academic Senate of Humboldt State University wishes to continue the custom calling for one vote per person; and be it further
- RESOLVED: That the Academic Senate of Humboldt State University recommends that when it is possible to plan in advance, an alternate should be sent as proxy to the Academic Senate of Humboldt State University; and be it further
- RESOLVED: That the Academic Senate of Humboldt State University recommends that in an extraordinary situation, when obtaining an alternate is not feasible, written proxy should be given to another Senator or to the Secretary or to the Chair of the Humboldt State University Academic Senate.
