

## ICC Consent Calendar 10/2/2018 University Senate Meeting

### 17-334 SOC 305: Modern World Systems

Course title change from "Modern World Systems" to "Global Transformations" in order to better express current literature and curriculum on the topic. New title also aligns better with the current catalog course description.

### 17-335 SOC 305M: Modern World Systems for Major

Course title change from "Modern World Systems for Major" to "Global Transformations for Majors" in order to better express current literature and curriculum on the topic. New title also aligns better with the current catalog course description.

### 17-347 MBA 630: Marketing Management for Shared Value

Changes to prerequisites (remove MBA 620, and retain MBA 605 and MBA 610) to better direct students who complete the degree over two years through the program in a more appropriately phased manner.

### 17-349 MBA 650: Designing Sustainable Organizations

Changes to prerequisites (remove MBA 610 and MBA 620, and retain MBA 605) to better direct students who complete the degree over two years through the program in a more appropriately phased manner.

### 17-350 MBA 675: Sustainability/Ethics

Changes to prerequisites (remove MBA 630 and MBA 640, retain MBA 650 & add MBA 605) to better direct students who complete the degree over two years through the program in a more appropriately phased manner.

### 17-351 MBA 679: Strategic Analysis

Changes to prerequisites (add MBA 605, MBA 610 and MBA 620, and retain MBA 630, MBA 640 and MBA 650) to better direct students who complete the degree over two years through the program in a more appropriately phased manner.

### 17-352 MBA 682: Business Internship

Added flexibility for internship units. Units will now be earned according to actual hours each semester, allowing students to extend their internships over multiple academic terms as appropriate. Also, removing all course prerequisites while maintaining the requirement that students must be in the MBA program to enroll.

### 17-278 Art Museum and Gallery Practices Certificate

The revised curriculum for the Museum and Gallery Practices Certificate introduces four disciplinary tracks: Art, Native American Studies, History, and Anthropology. The certificate program will now consist of three core classes plus an additional 9 units to be taken in the student's home department. These changes make our Certificate more in line with comparable undergraduate museum studies programs at other institutions, provide a more rigorous, interdisciplinary curriculum, and help student success and improve time to degree by offering discipline-specific tracks for students outside the Art Department who wish to pursue future careers in the museum and gallery world.

### 17-301 HED 451: Nutrition and Chronic Disease NEW COURSE PROPOSAL

Nutrition as a management strategy in the treatment of chronic diseases. Consideration of cardiovascular diseases, obesity and diabetes, and how they can be prevented and treated with

nutrition and associated lifestyle changes. This is a part of the new Nursing Program degree requirements.

#### 17-261 Film Major Program Change

The program proposes two changes:

- 1) Drop TA 448: Critical Analysis of Stage and Screen from the list of required courses, and replace it with an additional film production elective. Reason: TA 448 is a "film studies" course. The students get film studies in other courses, and they need more filmmaking skill-based courses.
- 2) Change FILM 477: Film/Digital Production by renumbering to 378, clarify that the course will have no pre-requisites, AND add a new course: FILM 478: Advanced Film/Digital Production that will have a pre-requisite of FILM 315: Filmmaking I. Both these courses will be on the list of Film Production electives. Students will take 8 units of Film Production electives.

This is associated with 17-262 and 17-263.

17-262 FILM 477: Film/Digital Production Workshop - change course number to 378, and revise course description to clarify that the course has no pre-requisites.

17-263 FILM 478: Advanced Film/Digital Production Workshop - New Course. C-4, variable units 1-4, pre-requisite of FILM 315. This course will be a more advanced version of FILM 378. Both courses will be available to students as electives.

#### 17-266 GEOG 352 Regional Climatology COURSE CHANGE proposal

Course title changed from "Regional Climatology" to "Weather, Climate, and Natural Hazards". Related course change for GEOG 352M (see 17-267).

#### 17-267 GEOG 352M Regional Climatology D.E. COURSE CHANGE proposal

Course title changed from "Regional Climatology D.E." to "Weather, Climate, and Natural Hazards D.E.". Related course change for GEOG 352 (see 17-266).

#### 17-269 GEOG 471 Topics in Systemic Geography COURSE CHANGE proposal

Course title changed from "Topics in Systemic Geography" to "Topics in Human Geography". The new title is more consistent with the content of the course and curriculum within the discipline.

#### 17-270 GEOG 471M Topics in Systemic Geography D.E. COURSE CHANGE proposal

Course title changed from "Topics in Systemic Geography D.E." to "Topics in Human Geography D.E.". The new title is more consistent with the content of the course and curriculum within the discipline.

#### 17-271 GEOG 473 Topics in Advanced Physical Geography COURSE CHANGE proposal

Course title changed from "Topics in Advanced Physical Geography" to "Topics in Physical Geography". The new title is more consistent with the content of the course and curriculum within the discipline, and this matches the existing title of GEOG 473M, the associated depth course.

#### 17-328 Anthropology Program Change for MA Applied Anthropology

Add the option of Exam + 3 units of additional electives (17-330) or a Thesis (17-329) (with the former as default and the latter requiring consultation with advisor). Revise elective requirements to allow

flexibility and remove the four emphases leaving a set of 8 core courses with the option of Thesis or Project/Electives and then allowing students to choose electives rather than having to pick courses from prearranged lists. It would be 9 units of electives for those in the Thesis track and 12 of electives for those in Exam track. The elective units can be inside or outside the program as long as they are approved by the advisor. Revise wording for summer institute. The revised wording replaces 5 weeks for the summer institute with 4 to 6 weeks and noting that part is on campus and part is online but not specifying the exact time for each and not being specific about what will be done thereby allowing greater flexibility. There is also a slight revision in the requirements for students with a bioarchaeology/forensics focus, removing some time limits and replacing the positioning of an actual human skeleton with an osteology exam as required skills. Three years of data are behind these suggested changes, which aim to improve student success and reduce time to graduation.

#### 17-329 ANTH 690 Thesis

Change the title to Thesis/Project and provide new course description "Thesis/project research and writing, peer review, and presentation of thesis or project for committee evaluation." Change the course from S-3 1-6 units to C-78 1-6 units, MOU attached. Grade mode is being changed to Mandatory Credit/No Credit and is repeatable for a total of 6 units.
