The relocation costs associated with finding an alternate space to JH 214 - currently serving as a lecture/lab room for several ERE course sections - will likely be shared between OAA and AA. Room modifications to the alternate space are expected to be minor, if any.

Space Allocation Details

Type of Space Needed

The Engineering Department requires an instructional space comparable to JH 214. We have identified GH 114 as a possible alternate space during the Jenkins Hall Renovation. After the renovation is complete, the Engineering Department would return to JH 214, and no longer require an alternate space.

Goal 4 Details:

Using a space like GH 114, which is slated to be vacated with the move of ACAC to the library, is an opportunity to limit the need for significant modifications to existing classrooms or labs, or to the expected program schedule of ERE or other academic programs that might be affected by accommodating ERE in their program spaces. Using GH 114 for courses normally scheduled in JH 214 may prove to be one of the least disruptive options, and thus contribute to our effectiveness as stewards of our built environment.
