Resolution on Administrative-Academic Probation and Disqualification

12-13/14-APC

Resolved: That the University Senate of Humboldt State University recommends to the President that the attached document, *Policy on Administrative-Academic Probation and Disqualification*, be approved for inclusion in the 2014-2015 HSU catalog.

Rationale: On September 15, 2008 CSU Chancellor Charles Reed issued, "Executive Order No. 1038 relating to minimum requirements for probation and disqualification" (see attached). As noted in the document, "In accordance with policy of the California State University, the campus president has the responsibility for implementing executive orders..." In accordance with the order, the language of EO 1038 has been incorporated into the proposed catalog language regarding administrative-academic probation and disqualification. Since policies in the HSU catalog already exist for academic probation and disqualification, these sections in EO 1038 are not addressed. Please note that in the proposed policy document, language adding additional student safeguards has been added. This language requires that decisions regarding administrative-academic probation and disqualification must be made in consultation with other relevant parties. Also, as directed by EO 1038, appeal processes for any student subject to this policy, have been developed.
