<b>Humboldt</b>	A composite score of <b>550</b> (computer based minimum score of 213) or higher	A waiver of the TOEFL may be granted by the International Evaluator on an individual basis for students who present a minimum grade of "B" or higher from a California Community College or University general education English Composition course or for applicants who have graduated from an accredited 4-year U.S. high school and have completed 4 years of English college preparation course work with grades of "B" or higher. IELI offers various Bridge programs to allow students to take regular university courses.
<i>Chico</i>	<i>International TOEFL score of 500 (computer based minimum of 173)</i>	<i>Eligible students will receive a letter of Conditional Admission from the university. Must maintain full-time enrollment at ALCI until admitted for university level coursework. Open University also allows you to enroll in regular university classes without formal admission to the university. Concurrent Enrollment allows students to enroll in regular university classes while attending ESL classes at ALCI.</i>
<i>Sonoma</i>	<i>500 on TOEFL (computer based score of 173)</i>	<i>International students who achieve 487-499 may be admitted to the SSU Language and Culture Bridge program.</i>
<i>San Francisco</i>	<i>500 for Undergraduates 550 for second B.A. students</i>	
<b>Maritime Academy</b>	<b>550</b> (computer based minimum score of 213)	
<b>Sacramento</b>	<i>A minimum score of <b>510</b> on the paper exam or 180 computer-based.</i>	
<b>Hayward</b>	<i>At least <b>500</b> (173 computer based)</i>	
<b>San Jose</b>	<b>550</b> (213 computer based)	TOEFL requirement can be waived if the student has completed 72 semester units or 108 quarter units in a U.S. institution.
<b>Stanislaus</b>	<i><b>500</b> for undergraduates (173 computer based) <b>550</b> for Masters Program</i>	<i>Students attending CSU Stanislaus ESL program (ALCP) can meet the CSU Stanislaus English proficiency requirement by completion of a specific course level and testing at minimal levels on an institutional TOEFL test. The university also cooperates with selected ESL programs to allow an exemption of TOEFL for undergraduate only.</i>
