Resolution on the Honorary Degree Nominating Committee

01-17/18-APC – September 5, 2017 – First Reading

RESOLVED: That the University Senate accepts the following changes to the Honorary Degree Nominating Committee.

RATIONALE: The changes make the Provost the committee chair, instead of the Vice President of Advancement. This change seems more appropriate given the nomination includes the award of an (honorary) academic degree. The changes remove one of the two Deans on the committee. This change better balances the administrative and faculty representation given that there are now only two faculty members on the committee: the Senate Chair and the Faculty President are now one person. Finally, the changes remove replication of CSU policy on this matter; instead, the policy simply refers to existing CSU policy.
