

Advising Working Group

Charge:

Develop a comprehensive proposal that identifies and coordinates advising activities in ways that efficiently and effectively facilitate student success. The model for student success is outlined in *Guided Pathways to Success*, which can be found at <http://www.completecollege.org/resources.html>. The plan will

- Include academic, career and co-curricular advising.
- Identify and coordinate appropriate roles for student, faculty and professional advisors.
- Focus advising resources where they are most effective.
- Identify when and how to intervene in order to keep students on a pathway to success.
- Recommend a structured advising process following the recommendations found in *Guided Pathways to Success*.
- Recommend areas for policy discussion by appropriate governance groups that would help facilitate student success.

Timeline:

- Fall 2013 – form working group
- March 28, 2014 – Make a recommendation to the Enrollment Management Working Group
- March 31, 2014 - May 2, 2014 Consult and approve advising plan
- Fall 2014 – Implementation

The working group is expected to keep the Enrollment Management Working Group, the University Senate and department chairs informed on its progress. It is expected to consult broadly with appropriate groups as it develops its recommendations.
