eLearning Required Course Features and Sample Schedules

Required Course Features

Instructors will create, with the assistance of the instructional designer and technical staff, the following eLearning course features:

- 1. A comprehensive course <u>syllabus</u> designed around one or more required textbooks or other learning materials Open textbooks or open education resources encouraged.
- 2. At least one video overview of the class for prospective students to view
- 3. An instructor biography with a personal photograph
- 4. Clearly <u>articulated academic outcomes and requirements</u> (e.g. student learning outcomes, course assignments, participation requirements, examinations, and evaluation rubrics)
- 5. Clearly articulated <u>expectations</u> for both student and instructor interaction expectations.
- 6. Instructional modules for each week of the course that include components of theory, practice, and assessment.
- 7. An <u>introductory set of activities</u> ("Module 0" or a "Week Zero") that introduce the student to the course and provide opportunities to learn how the course works.
- 8. Full ADA compliance (e.g. alt tags for images, video captioning, text equivalents for audio and multimedia). .
- 9. A Learning Management System grade book.
- 10. Appropriate strategies to promote academic honesty.
- 11. Appropriate copyright clearance or fair use standards (TEACH Act of 2002) for all online materials.
